Honorable Members of the Cheyenne City Council:-

The Citizens Tree Committee composed of J. F. Jenkins, Robert C. Morris, I. C. Whipple, H. R. Davis, J. O. Churchill ^{E. J. Slack} and W. C. Deming with the aid of the City Improvement Association having completed their labors in treeplanting for the season of 1902, submit the following report.

Over 2,000 cottonwood trees were secured and disposed of at an average cost of fifteen cents each. Besides the cottonwoods 2,000 white ash and maple seedlings have been planted under the direction of the City Improvement Association. The principal work accomplished has been the planting of two miles of trees along Ferguson Street and the Boulevard north of the city, and protecting the trees with a substantial wire fence. These trees are being cared for and watered by the city and are growing finely. This improvement has been entirely defrayed by voluntary subscriptions and reflects great credit upon the citizens of Cheyenne in their efforts to beautify the city. Next season it is hoped with the cooperation of the military authorities a line of trees on both sides the driveway may be extended to Fort Russell a distance of three miles.

The total amount expended under the direction of the tree committee will approximate \$875⁰⁰, a list of the subscribers having been published in the daily papers. All subscribers have been enrolled as members of the City Improvement Association and comprise 250 adults and 330 school children, an alphabetical list of which ~~xxxx~~ is hereto attached. Applications for membership will be received by the treasurer or secretary. Many vacant places along the residence streets have been lined with trees, and with few exceptions citizens have been willing to make these improvements at their own expense when the trees are furnished at reasonable prices. This season the association have provided cottonwood trees and planted them at forty cents each. A better way

would be for the city authorities to fill up these ~~out~~ places along the outer side of the sidewalk with trees as is done in Washington, Colorado Springs and many other cities. The streets belong to the municipality and their improvement should be as much a matter of pride as the public park system. We trust that the interest that has been awakened in beautifying the city will be fostered in every way as the success of the movement is sure ^{in the future} to be a source of gratification and pride to every citizen of Cheyenne.
